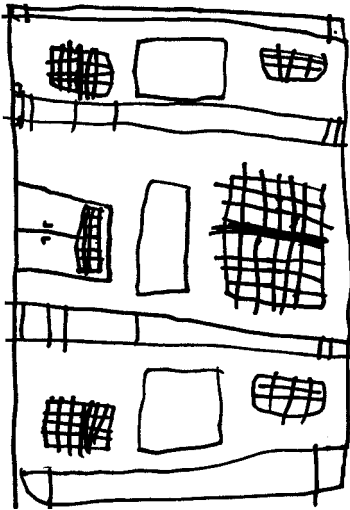

Junior Program

We will accept 5 year old campers, if they have completed kindergarten. The 6 to 8 year old camper is assigned to one peer group, takes classes with that same group. All Junior camper groups have a "Lead Counselor" who assist and travel with them to all their classes. Classes rotate on a Monday/Wednesday/Friday and Tuesday/Thursday, with a (Mon. Wed., Fri.) swim and a (Tues., Thurs.) outdoor game period.

The 6, 7 and 8 year old class offerings may include:

- Drama (Theater Games & Improvisation)
- Ceramics • Visual Art • Stretch & Move • Puppet Making
- Music • Creative Movement • Sports and Games
- Small Group Percussion, Violin or Piano
- Sculpture • Square Dancing

Jr. Campers will walk to nearby Volta/Georgetown Pool and Playground three days a week. The other two days Junior campers will have outdoor games & activities.

Senior Program

The 9 to 14 year old camper has the opportunity to shape his or her summer schedule by selecting from a variety of course offerings that rotate on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday, and Tuesday and Thursday basis.

Typical Senior Class Selections

Seniors will select all their classes two weeks before each session begins on a first come first serve basis. We reserve the right to place campers in appropriate classes based on skill level and experience.

Please Note: during our 4 day Early Bird Week, Sr. Campers will have the same classes each day

Typical Senior Day Program

Morning meeting, Big Class (hour 1 M-W-F), Big Class (hour 2 M-W-F), 2 add. 1 hour Class (Tu-Th), Indoor/Outdoor Games, LUNCH, 3rd Class, Class 4 (M-W-F), Class 5 (M-W-F), Swim/Outdoor Games at Volta/Georgetown Pool & Playground (Tu-Th). Seniors will walk to their Tues./Thurs. swim.

MIDDLE SCHOOL-AGED campers may attend AFTERNOONS ONLY (12:30 - 3:45 PM) on a daily basis for session I or II. They will select two, one-hour classes on M•W•F and have an additional class plus outdoor game/swim period on Tues. •Thurs.

PLEASE NOTE: Class selections for Junior Groups and Seniors may vary from session to session due to teacher availability and scheduling.

Class selection lists, additional camp information, and necessary camper forms will be sent to registered campers 1-2 weeks before each session.

Camp Hours

9:00 am to 3:45 pm • Monday through Friday

The camp day begins at 9:00 am. Children may be dropped off after 8:30 am. Campers **MUST NOT** arrive before 8:30 am as **NO** supervision is provided. **A half-day, afternoon only, program will be offered to senior campers (only) Ages 12-14, for Sessions I or II.**

AFTER CAMP Program: We offer an After Camp Program **from 3:45-6:00 pm.** The program will provide a relaxed environment with snacks, outdoor games and playground time for a limited number of campers. After Camp will enforce heavy late fees after 6:00 PM. We will use nearby Jelleff Boys & Girls Club for a portion of our after camp day

Meals And Transportation

Each camper is responsible for bringing his/her own lunch (no refrigeration of lunches). Lemonade will be provided during a daily mid-morning break. Parents must notify Fillmore in writing, if a camper has any food restrictions or allergies.
